Affordable at South Olive Christian School

South Olive Christian School partners with families to raise up the next generation of fearless Kingdom builders. For 70 years, SOCS families have believed access to a Christ-centered education that fosters a love for Jesus Christ should be affordable regardless of economic means. To make this dream a reality, we incorporate Parent Service Hours into the cost of tuition. SOCS also offers grants and aid.

Parent Service Hours

SOCS is a special place where we join together to create a "parent-partnered, Christ-centered, affordable" environment where our children learn, grow and become strong Kingdom builders. The Parent Service Hours performed by each family/household earn the school about \$1,000/family which is used to keep tuition low for all students. SOCS has one of the lowest Christian school tuitions in the area because of the famous Pig in the Blanket fundraising effort. Parent Service Hours can be completed by participating in SOCS Famous Pigs &/or SOCS Auction.

Parent Service Hours can be completed any time from July 2022-July 2023.





Option #1: SOCS Famous Pigs

SOCS Famous Pigs is a time-honored fundraiser at South Olive that runs year around. The production of the famous Pigs in the Blanket has become so popular within the community that production is being taken to a new level in 2022. This endeavor raises incredible funds for SOCS which helps keep the tuition low for all families. The work is easy and fun! No experience required but be ready to have a lot of fun! Pigs are made all year long. (There is no longer a \$10/hour tuition credit for pigs.)

Option #2: SOCS Auction

The school's largest fundraiser, raising \$75,000/year, requires many hands to bring it to life. There are all types of job responsibilities from item procurement to event day set-up so there is a job perfect for you. The auction takes place in April.


